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**Withdrawal of Transportation Privileges**

1. Students, while being conveyed on school transportation, are subject to the disciplinary authority of the Principal, Vice Principal, or Teacher-in-Charge, and shall behave in a manner so as to allow the driver or operator to give his/her attention to safe operations.
  - (a) Students are expected to comply with reasonable requests of bus drivers and boat drivers.
2. Bus drivers or boat operators shall report misbehaviour to the Principal, Vice Principal, or Teacher-in-Charge who shall take such action as he/she sees fit subject to the following:

A Principal, Vice Principal, or Teacher-in-Charge:

  - (a) may withdraw transportation privileges from a student for up to five consecutive school days provided notice is given to the parent or guardian prior to the withdrawal of the services, or alternate interim transportation is arranged.
  - (b) shall report the withdrawal of services to the Superintendent of Schools.
  - (c) may recommend a longer period of withdrawal of service to the Superintendent of Schools.
3. For withdrawals of service in excess of five days, the Superintendent of Schools shall convene a meeting with the student, parents or guardians, Principal, Vice Principal, or Teacher-in-Charge, boat operator or bus driver, and one trustee for the purpose of reviewing the withdrawal.
