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Outdoor Recreational Areas

Any group desiring to construct an outdoor recreational area shall, prior to the start of construction, submit a working diagram drawn to scale indicating dimensions of all materials to be used and special treating thereof, and details of sub-surface construction to the Manager of Facilities and the Operations Committee for review. The committee shall do one or more of the following, called Phase One:

- (1) Approve the plan
- (2) Reject the plan
- (3) Send the plan back for clarification or additional information
- (4) Send the plan back for suggested alternations

When Phase One has been satisfactorily completed, the group shall be given notice of approval to begin construction.

The group shall notify the Manager of Facilities when the construction is completed in order that a final inspection and approval for use may be given.

The Operations Committee, through the Manager of Facilities, shall upon request, provide available CSA (Canadian Standards Association) standards together with pertinent comments relating to all proposed playground equipment and adventure playgrounds.
