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Alcohol – Buildings, Grounds And Functions

1. Special permits to allow the consumption of alcohol on school district properties at community events must meet these requirements:
 - a. The request is provided in writing to the Board of Education at least 60 days prior to the event (this request will need to be discussed and approved at a Board of Education meeting);
 - b. The conditions will ensure the safety and care of school district personnel and property;
 - c. All restrictions expressed and implied by the British Columbia Government Liquor Act are enforced. Special Occasion Licenses are issued under the Liquor Control and Licensing Act to authorize the selling or serving of liquor at the place designated in the license;
 - d. There is demonstrated planning for the security and control of the function with a named person responsible;
 - e. That groups involved with any activity where liquor is served, are required to provide proof of third party liability insurance of a minimum \$3,000,000;
 - f. These, and other rental agreement terms, are agreed to.
2. The consumption of alcoholic beverages is permitted only during the hours and the areas agreed upon as stated on the Agreement for the Use of School Facilities issued by the school district.
3. The school district assumes no expressed, implied, or intended liability for groups who dispense alcohol.
