BC's draft *Framework for Enhancing Student Learning* reflects a public commitment by education partners to work together to continuously improve student learning for each student. Elements of the Framework include:

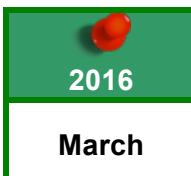
1. A system-wide focus on intellectual, human, and social, and career development.

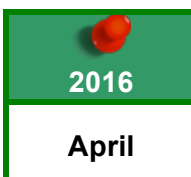

DRAFT DISTRICT & SCHOOL PLANNING CYCLE

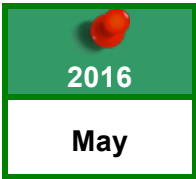


The district's former Planning Day was moved from May to the end of March and scheduled to coincide with non-instructional curriculum days. The schedule of events can be found at:

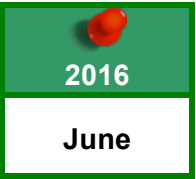

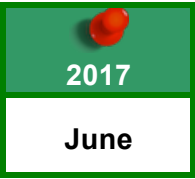
