POLICY 133 Addressing Concerns

Rationale:

In the spirit of fairness and due process, the School District No. 64 Board of Education (the board) welcomes comments, questions and concerns regarding the decisions made by the board or its employees, where these are deemed to adversely affect the education, health or safety of students.

Policy:

The Board of Education believes that concerns are generally best dealt with at the point closest to where the concern first arises. The appeal process, as outlined in the board’s Bylaw No. 3, shall enable good faith efforts to address concerns and resolve disputes to the mutual satisfaction of the parties involved.

The board also recognizes that concerns about employee decisions that do not significantly affect the education, health or safety of a student are within the final authority of the Superintendent.
