POLICY 407 Supervision of Students

*“Inspire learners, Integrate sustainability,

Rationale:

The principal is responsible for administering and supervising the school, including the general conduct of students, both on school premises and during school-sponsored activities both off school grounds and outside of school hours. Teachers are responsible for providing such assistance as is necessary, for the supervision of students on school premises and at school functions whenever and wherever held. Parents and community members provide further assistance as requested, usually in a voluntary capacity.

Policy:

The School District No. 64 Board of Education directs principals to ensure that all students receive supervision adequate to the situation and appropriate to their ages and developmental levels and abilities while attending school and participating in school functions. Expectations regarding the levels and kinds of supervision necessary in a particular activity must be clearly articulated to all adult supervisors. The needs of particular students for a different level or type of supervision must be considered, on a situation-by-situation basis.
