1. Care and control of school facilities and equipment is delegated to school principals, who may make these available for use by the community, according to established procedures and joint-use agreements. (See Policy and Procedure 685)
2. Users of the Pender Islands Activity Centre are subject to provisions outlined in Procedure 6850.
3. Fees will be charged for the use of the Pender Islands Activity Centre, as follows:
 - a. Groups using the community room for meetings only. No charge
 - b. Youth groups using the Activity Centre for sports where no membership fees are levied. No charge.
 - c. Organized youth groups charging a membership fee that meet on a regular weekly basis; for example, Boy Scouts, Girl Guides. \$200 per year/group.
 - d. Commercial/Private/Individual users:
 - i. Any group or individual booking the Activity Centre on a weekly basis that charges a fee will pay one dollar (\$1.00) per person, with a \$10 minimum set for each use, to recover the cost of heat, light and other expenses incurred.
 - ii. Any group or individual who charges an entry fee at the door or by advance ticket sales will be charged the rate of one dollar (\$1.00) per person, with a \$10 minimum set for each use, to recover the cost of heat, light and other expenses incurred.
 - iii. Private adult groups using the Activity Centre on an ongoing weekly basis (for example, badminton and volleyball clubs) will pay one dollar (\$1.00) per person, with a \$10 minimum set for each use to recover the cost of heat, light and other expenses incurred.
 - iv. Private functions involving the school gymnasium. \$150 per day/24 hour period.
