 - Documented experience with functional behaviour assessment methodology.

 - Valid First Aid certification w/CPR.
 - Valid B.C. class 5 driver's license and access to an appropriately insured vehicle for purposes of work.
 - Two years of successful school and/or community related experience in the field of Child and Youth Care.
 - Documented evidence of exemplary interpersonal skills and ability to work independently and as a member of a team.
